

June till August: daily 11 a.m. – 2 p.m.


If the flags are showing in the windows, the tower is open.

### WELCOME TO THE ROEDERTOWER!

The Roedertower, dating back to the 14th century, is the only accessible tower along the wall and is situated on the eastern side. For a long time it was an important watchtower for the town. Its bastion was added in the 16th century as reinforcement against invading troops.

At the end of World War II it burnt down and soon afterwards the reconstruction started with the help of the society Alt-Rothenburg.

After climbing 103 steps you'll have a brilliant view over the town with its medieval lanes and you get an impression of the towns surroundings.

Furthermore there is a little exhibition about the destruction of the town caused by bombings at the end of World War II.
